Local Youth Loses Leg In Omaha, Neb.

Elmer Fulkerson Victim Of Bad Accident In West Monday

Elmer Fulkerson, 19, son of Mr. and Mrs. Gordon Fulkerson, had his right leg amputated in a hospital in Omaha, Nebraska, Monday, according to word received from officials of that city by his parents, Tuesday.

According to information received by his parents, Fulkerson had been to California and was on his way back to Chicago to attend the World's Fair. He hitch-hiked his way and attempted to ride part of the distance on a freight train, when he fell under the cars and had his leg so badly crushed that amputation was necessary. He was said to be getting along nicely from the operation.

The young man attended the Greenfield schools and is well and favorably known in this community. His sister, Mabel, is employed at the Wilknit Hosiery Co. He left for the west about 6 weeks ago.
